1. Definitions

In these regulations, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Fire Brigade Services Act, 1987 (Act No. 99 of 1987), shall bear the meaning so assigned thereto and unless the context otherwise indicates -

"Act" means the Fire Brigade Services Act, 1987 (Act No. 99 of 1987);

"National Fire Services Framework" or "Framework" means a Framework contemplated in regulation 2.

2. National Fire Services Framework

(1)

(a) The Minister, after consultation with the Fire Brigade Board, must prepare a National Fire Service Framework applicable to controlling authorities that sets out the medium term Key Performance

Indicators and Objectives which are aimed at guiding and directing the planning and provision of a service.

- (b) The Framework contemplated in paragraph (a) must promote -
 - (i) public safety; and
 - (ii) the efficiency and effectiveness of services.
- (c) The Minister, after consultation with the Fire Brigade Board, may review the National Fire Services Framework as required.

3. Commencement

These Regulations take effect on the date of publication thereof in the Government Gazette.

4. Short Title

These Regulations are called the National Fire Services Framework Regulations, 2010.
