The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The Energy Regulator's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003) ('the Petroleum Pipelines Act').

Stakeholders are notified that NERSA has published the Amended Rules made in terms of section 33(3) of the Petroleum Pipelines Act (Petroleum Pipelines Rules), as required by the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004).
